Wind Power Development Proposed for Schreiber, Ontario

In a joint announcement, Anemos Energy Corporation and the Township of Schreiber, Ontario have entered into an agreement which will allow Anemos Energy to investigate the feasibility of developing a wind energy project on Township owned land in the Mount Gwynn area. The project, once completed, will have a rated capacity of up to 10 megawatts (MW), enough power for approximately 2600 average Ontario homes. The project will consist of 5 to 10 wind turbines of 1 to 2 MW capacity each.

An open meeting will be conducted in the coming weeks to provide more details about the proposed project. The meeting will also help Anemos Energy obtain feedback from the community. Prior to proceeding with construction, a wind assessment study will be undertaken to determine the site's suitability, as well as obtaining necessary environmental and municipal approvals. Consultation with the community and Town officials will be a primary goal throughout the development process.

"I look forward to partnering with the residents of the Township of Schreiber to contribute to the town's economy and to generate clean, renewable energy. Wind power will reduce our province's contribution to green house gas emissions while providing a reliable, affordable energy source for the future," comments Rob Parsons, President of Anemos Energy Corporation.

Anthony Friedrich, Community Development Officer for the Township of Schreiber is pleased with the deal. "This is a great opportunity for the Township of Schreiber to work with the private sector to build more infrastructure and diversify its economic base while helping the environment," Mr. Friedrich commented.

Anemos Energy Corporation is a Canadian wind energy project developer with projects under development in various jurisdictions throughout North America. Anemos Energy's vision is to develop environmentally responsible power generation projects which utilize renewable resources and produce zero greenhouse gas emissions, while producing economic benefit to the regions which are selected for development.

The Township of Schreiber, Ontario, located on the north shore of Lake Superior between Sault Ste Marie and Thunder Bay, is home to approximately 1,200 residents with roughly 130,000 people within a two-hour drive. The township is located in a valley surrounded by rugged hills and is on one of the most northerly points of Lake Superior.
