



## INCINERATORS

Use is NOT allowed if the Province or Municipality have declared a Restricted Fire Zone (RFZ), a Provincial Burn Ban or suspended all burn permits.

**You can burn wood, brush, leaves or wood by-products only, (no kitchen garbage, or any material prohibited by the Environmental Protection Act) in an incinerator, provided you meet all of the following conditions:**

- The incinerator must be an enclosed device constructed entirely of non-combustible material.
- A screen having a mesh size of not more than 5mm (1/4 inch) covers the entire top.
- The size and volume of the device is the same as a 45 gallon barrel or smaller.
- The incinerator is at least 6 meters (20 feet) from any forest or woodland.
- The incinerator is at least 6 meters (20 feet) from any flammable or combustible material.
- You have a recreational burn permit.
- A responsible person attends the fire until it is extinguished.
- The **property owner** is still **liable** if the fire is not contained.
