At 8:06 pm on Thursday August 1, 2024, Mayor Kevin Mullins declared a 'State of Emergency' regarding the Schreiber Wastewater Treatment Plant. The Schreiber Wastewater Plant operates with two (2) clarifiers, numbered one (1) and two (2). Clarifier One (1) experienced a structural failure which allowed water to enter the digester, thus preventing proper wastewater treatment. Clarifier Two (2) was operational but subsequently suffered a mechanical failure of the rake system. A contractor is onsite pumping out Clarifier Two (2), estimated completion 2024-08-02.

Once Clarifier Two (2) has been drained and cleaned completely the necessary repairs can begin. This in no way affects our residents or businesses in their daily use of water or our sewer system. We will update the public as repairs are made. This is a precautionary measure and will have no impact on the ratepayer.
